Please Note:

The amount the Church is able to recover is very substantial. Now the basic rate of tax is 20%, Gift Aid is 20p per 80p given (ie 25p per £1). However, for the three tax years to 2010/11, transitional relief will be paid topping Gift Aid up to the previous total of 28p in the £1.

Also higher rate taxpayers are entitled to claim a personal refund equal to the difference between the HR and BR (now 40p-20p=20p per 80p given).
